



SEVEN WONDERS OF THE LAND OF ŠIAULIAI

THE HILL OF CROSSES with over 200,000 crosses. Every year, the hill is visited by thousands of tourists from all over the world.

SUNDIAL SQUARE with the highest sundial in Lithuania and a gilded sculpture “Šaulys” (“Archer”) that has become the city’s symbol.

THE ENSEMBLE OF TYTUVĖNAI CHURCH AND MONASTERY – one of the most interesting and largest examples of Lithuanian sacral architecture, adorned with frescoes, dating back to the 17th-18th centuries.


THE BUTTERFLY EXPOSITION – you will find the largest collection of diurnal butterflies in Lithuania in the Akmenė Regional Museum.

CHERRIES OF ŽAGARĖ – a four-day cherry festival and the election of the most beautiful scarecrow in one of the most unique Lithuanian towns in Joniškis land.

WINDMILLS OF PAKRUOJIS – the wind accelerating in wide plains is turning the vanes of as many as 18 windmills.

THE TULIP FLOWERING FESTIVAL – held every spring in the Burbiškis manor, Radviliškis land; as many as half a thousand tulip species burst into flower.





The centre of the city, which was twice destroyed during the wars of the 20th century and rebuilt again, has distinct architectural heritage of the interwar period modernism, which has survived to this day. Šiauliai is a city-phoenix, every time rising from ashes.

Discover Šiauliai and experience the magic of 3 "S": sweets, special museums, and the sun.


The symbols of the sun, scattered all over the city (sundials, stained glass, etc.), have become an integral part of the city. The oldest sweet factory of Lithuania, "Rūta", operating for over 100 years, special museums of chocolate, photography, telephony, and the only such Vanda Kavaliauskienė's Cats Museum with over 4000 exhibits.

1. ŠIAULIAI BOULEVARD

In 1975, we were brave – the third in Europe and the first in Lithuania who turned the central part of Vilnius Street into a boulevard. We decorated the pedestrian boulevard with original sculptures of small architecture, volumetric adverts, again pleasantly cheering and surprising everyone and turning the boulevard into a cosy and the most important Šiauliai residents' place of leisure, recreation, entertainment, and trade.



2. ST APOSTLES PETER AND PAUL'S CATHEDRAL

The monument of Renaissance architecture St Peter and Paul's Cathedral is the most striking landmark of the city. The apex of the tower (its height is 70 m) can be seen from a distance, approaching Šiauliai from any side.

On May 8, 1997, by the decision of Pope John Paul II, Šiauliai diocese was founded. The church became St Apostles Peter and Paul's Cathedral. One of the oldest sundials in Lithuania is constructed on the southern facade of the cathedral.

3. SUNDIAL SQUARE

The architectural ensemble consists of an amphitheatre-shaped square and an 18-meter-high obelisk, crowned with a gilded sculpture of a running archer. On a sunny day, the obelisk with the archer's figure turn into a gnomon [gnōmōn from Greek is the arrow of the sundial]. The Sun's shadow moving along the dial face with metal numbers infused into the square (12, 3 and 6) shows the local time of the geographical latitude. The numbers indicate the date of the Battle of the Sun – 1236. This is when the name of Šiauliai was mentioned for the first time.

..... 4. CHAIMAS FRENKELIS' VILLA



The villa attracts by its preserved wood trim of the interior, ornate moldings, fragments of paintings, stylized expositions reflecting Lithuanian province manor and the interwar period in Šiauliai. The villa built by a famous Jewish family Dora and Chaimas Frenkeliai in 1908 is the only Secession style building in the Baltic States, fascinating by its beauty and perfection.

In 2018, the villa's yard was enriched by the ornate fountain and a rosarium of a thousand roses, giving even more splendour to this space.

The villa cherishes Jewish culture.

The newly built tanner's workshop familiarises its visitors with the traditional tanner's craft.

..... 5. "RŪTA" CHOCOLATE MUSEUM



"Rūta" is one of the oldest sweet factories in Lithuania, operating since 1913. The old building of the factory houses the Chocolate Museum of "Rūta". The exposition of the museum presents both an interesting history of the factory and opens up secrets and peculiarities of chocolate consumption, lasting four millennia. The museum offers interactive sessions and organises themed chocolate and sweets tasting events.

The museum is neighboured by the sweet shop of "Rūta" and a café.

..... 6. VANDA KAVALIAUSKIENĖ'S CATS MUSEUM



The visitors of the museum founded by Vanda Kavaliauskienė in 1990, named after her, are gladly met by cats and the naughty cat Perlas, also called the director of the museum. Three halls of the museum are full of cats, cats, cats... They have come not only from the most different corners of Lithuania but also from many countries of the world. The museum is neighboured by a wildlife garden that is a home to the python, king rat snake, Amur rat snake, corn snake, Taiwanese beauty rat snake, lizards, crocodiles, and even a cute little monkey.

There are over 20 museums in Šiauliai, and you will find the BICYCLE Museum and the CATS Museum only in Šiauliai – they are unique in Lithuania.

..... 7. THE BICYCLE MUSEUM

The only museum dedicated to the history of bicycles in Lithuania was founded in 1980 at the Šiauliai bicycle and engine factory “Vairas”. One of the oldest exhibits of the museum is the children’s tricycle with red velvet-sheathed wooden saddle, forged from iron in 1905. Another attractive exhibit is the wooden prototype of the bicycle – “celerifere” or “the running machine”, which in 1792 was ridden by count Mede de Sivrac in Paris, pushing his feet against the ground.

..... 8. SCULPTURE “THE IRON FOX”.....

It is recorded in Lithuania’s Book of Records that it is the largest animal sculpture: its weight is nearly 7 tons, length is about 15 meters, and height is 6,6 meters.

The steel heart of the Iron Fox (1,20 meters high and 0,90 meters wide) contains a capsule with words engraved on the copper plate for future generations. This is the work of art designed by the designer of Šiauliai Vilius Puronas to commemorate the millennium of the first mention of the name of Lithuania.

....9. THE MONUMENT TO THE LITHUANIAN CURRENCY - “THE CENTS ROOM”.....

The Cents Room appeared as a monument to Lithuanian currency, when it was decided to introduce the Euro in Lithuania. People from all over Lithuania came to stick cents, while those who did not have this possibility, sent cents by post. This way, coins donated by people laid flat on the ceiling and walls of one room in the library of Šiauliai University. There is also a symbolic throne, over which a huge one-Litas coin and a map of Lithuania are hung. The Cents Room was made from 157 130 coins.

10. THE PHOTOGRAPHY MUSEUM



The museum is located in the authentic building representing modern architecture of the interwar period of the 20th century, right in the centre of Šiauliai. It is the only museum of such type in Lithuania, a particularly important photography storage and representation centre.

The reconstructed museum has a modern gallery, educational space, photo laboratory, reading room and information centre, shop of souvenirs and publications, there is a panoramic viewpoint with the “camera obscura” on the outdoor roof terrace.

11. ŽALIŪKIAI MILLER'S HOMESTEAD



Žaliūkiai Miller's Homestead is a space of ethno-culture, traditional customs and entertainments, surrounded by the modern city. The homestead consists of the restored miller's house and the only surviving building of Lithuanian traditional wooden architecture of the second half of the 19th century in Šiauliai – Žaliūkiai windmill.

Popular workshops “Bread Baking”, “The Excursion with a Miller and Bread Tasting” are held in the miller's house.

12. THE VENCLAUSKIAI HOUSE



It is a distinct object of the modernist architecture of the interwar period, unique and one of the most characteristic examples of private interior painting decor of the first half of the 20th century in Lithuania. The cultural heritage site restored in 2019 presents historical exhibitions, hosts events and workshops, and has an open reading room. “Našlaičių sodas” (“The Orphans' Garden”) invites visitors to enjoy themselves in the children's playground, rest, and socialize. The museum exposition tells the history of the city of Šiauliai in the first half of the 20th century and reveals the place of an exceptional, national, civic, and active large family of the Venclauskiai in it.





ART IN THE CITY

80 butterflies, a runaway hairstyle of a princess, a fox, pigeons, burning armour or a worker – these are the hints of what to look for on the walls of buildings. Have you ever seen balconies adorned with street art drawings? You will find them on the boulevard – raise your heads.

Green but not grass, with a tail but not a mouse and not a cucumber at all. What? You will see a chameleon that has squirmed in a tree on the boulevard. There are even more unexpectedly sized animal sculptures in the city. They all make up the street “zoo”.

Volumetric advertisements are an exceptional legacy found only in Šiauliai: black cancer on a pack of cigarettes, warning of the harm of smoking; two giant books “placed” on a column; or five black cats “walking” on the roof of a pharmacy.

Let us stop at the city’s clock “Gaidys” (“A Cock”). “Gaidys” not only sings but also welcomes passers-by in English, German, French, Russian, Spanish, Swedish, Romani, and other languages at midday and 6 p.m.

There is ...a shoe tree growing in Šiauliai! When the cycling and skateboarding season is over, teenagers throw their shoes on the tree branches. This recurs year after year. We are going to look for it!



Every step is a new discovery in Akmenė land both speaking about its natural history and the legends of the district itself. The land of Akmenė reconciles the seemingly incompatible things: the verdurous shores of the Venta River and the landscape of harsh quarries, cosy towns and factory chimneys smoking all 24 hours, dinosaurs and butterflies, and mounds and swamps.

TOP OBJECTS

.....13. AKMENĖ REGIONAL MUSEUM



The Akmenė Regional Museum can make you feel like in a kind of jungle where you can admire a swarm of exotic butterflies. Butterflies of different species are very homey – all you have to do is stretch out the delicious fruit, and they come flying to eat straightaway. The museum is also home to other butterflies – the country's largest collection of diurnal butterflies, collected by Boris Izenbek, one of the most prominent butterfly collectors in Lithuania, is kept and displayed here. Some of them, unfortunately, cannot be found in nature any longer, while a dozen types of exhibits in the collection are on the verge of extinction and are now strictly preserved. As a contrast to the homely butterflies, you can also see the fossils – fossilized remains of the harsh Jurassic period.

.....14. KAMANOS STATE STRICT NATURE RESERVE

Kamanos is not a derivative of the word *kamanės* (bumblebee). Therefore, do not be afraid and get ready to visit Kamanos State Strict Nature Reserve. We count: 12 boggy areas and over 120 lakelets. The swamp is adorned by lakelets Nimfėjai and Salos with picturesque shores and the 6-hectare Lake Kamanos. As many as 26 species of protected plants have been found in the strict nature reserve; this place is also visited even by lynxes, wolves, and hazel dormice. It is quite common that the visitor is lucky to see all the living treasures of that land. Those who want to get to know the natural values preserved in the strict nature reserve in more detail are welcome at the modern and up-to-date visitor centre.

.....15. VENTA REGIONAL PARK

The territory of Venta Regional Park is an exceptional place due to its geological structure and beautiful landscape. This is where one can see the surviving rocks of the Jurassic Period, dating back millions of years, and touch the fossils – the remains of animals that were alive at the time of the dinosaurs. The park has 1 strict nature reserve, 8 nature reserves, and 16 exclusive natural heritage sites, 2 of which have been labelled as natural monuments. Visitors can learn more about natural and cultural heritage sites in the exposition hall equipped in the modern visitor centre of Venta Regional Park. Interactive stands and the reproduced sounds of nature allow visitors to experience an immediate sense of nature.

.....16. LAZDYNŲ PELĖDA'S MEMORIAL MUSEUM

Lazdynų Pelėda (An Owl of Hazelnut) is a unique phenomenon in the history of Lithuanian literature: two sisters Ivanauskaitės signed their prose works and published them under one joint pseudonym. Lazdynų Pelėda's Memorial Museum has been opened in the building of the Paragai Manor residential house – the writers' childhood home. Photographs, books and documents explaining an interesting path of life and creative work of Sofija Ivanauskaitė-Pšibiliauskienė (1867-1926) and Marija Ivanauskaitė-Lastauskienė (1872-1957) are exhibited in the residential part of the house and the attic. The museum also exhibits photocopies of pictures of writers' father – Nikodemas Ivanauskas (1839-1932), who was a painter and a professional artist.

17. AKMENĖ NATURE AND CULTURE PARK



Nature and Culture Park was established in the pine forest of Akmenė town in 2002. The park area consists of the pine wood, the Dabikinė River valley, a former sand quarry, and the shore of the pond. The park is abundant with wooden sculptures and has a unique stone stage. It is a venue for various cultural events, a great place for recreation and leisure. This is a great place to relax or, conversely, to spend your free time actively.

18. SIMONAS DAUKANTAS' MEMORIAL MUSEUM



In 1986, the museum to commemorate Simonas Daukantas, a historian who was the first to write the history of Lithuania in the Lithuanian language, was founded in the house where he once lived. Currently, the museum has about 300 exhibits. Among them – the chair from apple tree branches made by the enlightener himself, fossils of the Papilė outcrop dating back to the Jurassic period, and finds of the burial ground. Here, visitors can get familiar with various documentary material, memories of famous people, telling about this prominent Samogitian.

19. JURAKALNIS OBSERVATION TOWER



Jurakalnis geological outcrop and spur are neighbored by a 15-meter observation tower. Having climbed the top of the tower, tourists can enjoy a wonderful view to the expressive valley of the Venta River, Papilė town and places to visit: Jurakalnis geological outcrop and spur, Papilė mounds I and II, St Joseph's Church, and the 15-stem lime-tree.

20. NAUJOJI AKMENĖ CULTURE HOUSE

The new Akmenė Culture House built in 1958 is one of the most striking monuments witnessing the town's history. This is one of the most expressive architectural examples of the Stalinist era in Lithuania, which had to demonstrate the advantage of the new Soviet regime over the West or the 'bourgeois Lithuania'. The artistic and architectural expression of such buildings embodies the early task of the Soviet-era ideologists to cherish "cultural leisure of working people". The building houses an exhibition hall abundant in unique works of the country's most famous artists.

21. ŠALTIŠKIAI CLAY QUARRY

The quarries, otherwise known as Lithuanian Martian canyons, surprise visitors with a landscape uncharacteristic of Lithuania. A walk in the Šaltiškiai clay quarry will make one feel like on another planet, because due to clay layers the quarry has acquired a reddish colour. In Early Triassic times, 250 million years ago, a desert climate hovered here, and giant dinosaurs walked along the current quarry. It was namely in the Šaltiškės clay quarry that two teeth and the remains of two jaws of reptiles of the Triassic geological period – phytosaurs' fossils – were found. 

22. MENČIAI LIMESTONE QUARRY

Menčiai Limestone Quarry attracts tourists to walk in the 'undiscovered land' – the bottom of the future lake. When the quarry is no longer used, it will be flooded with water. Walking in Menčiai Limestone Quarry, one can perfectly see excavated quarry limestone outcrops and even forget that this is the land of plains, where it is difficult to find a higher hill. Semigallia is a historical region that once stretched across Latvian and Lithuanian territories. It is popular for its historical heritage of Semigallian tribes. Nowadays, the Lithuanian part of Semigallia is an unofficial subregion of Aukštaitija, that stretches along the border of Latvia. This region is united by the mutual heritage of tribal origin, history and its relics, as well as the rebellious Semigallian spirit. The largest town titled as the capital of the present-day Lithuanian part of Semigallia is Joniškis. We invite you to experience Semigallian spirit of Joniškis district.

23. JONIŠKIS CHURCH OF THE ASSUMPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY INTO HEAVEN



The church history dates back to 1536, when on the initiative of Vilnius bishop Jonas the territory inhabited as early as in the 7th century was baptized. In 1901, the church acquired the current appearance and the stepped cross-shaped plan. The interior of the church is particularly ornate and majestic. Its accent is symmetrically positioned 7 neo-Baroque brick altars. The niches of the walls are adorned with neo-Baroque sculptures of the Blessed Virgin Mary of Sorrows, St Casimir, St Joseph, Christ the Lord of the World and other saints, made by professional sculptors. The paintings on the ceiling of the church depict biblical narratives.

24. THE COMPLEX OF SYNAGOGUES IN JONIŠKIS

The complex of synagogues consists of two synagogues: The White Synagogue and The Red Synagogue. The unique interior of The Red Synagogue, such as ceiling decorations, wall paintings, Torah ark or holy ark (hebr. aron kodesh), where once the Torah scrolls were kept, was recreated and restored. The synagogue displays an exposition “Jewish History and Culture of Joniškis Region”, which represents the history of the Jewish community of Joniškis till the start of World War II. The exposition of The White Synagogue creatively conveys the historical development of Joniškis and the most important moments in the history of the city using modern means of exhibition.

25. JONIŠKIS BASKETBALL MUSEUM

There is a saying “basketball is like a second religion in Lithuania”; however, for a prolonged period of time there was no place for fans, athletes and anyone interested in this sport to see the most famous achievements, attributes, and historical photos of the country’s basketball players. Therefore, in 2009, the only basketball museum in Lithuania was opened in Joniškis. The museum has a special room to celebrate the victory of the Lithuanian basketball team in 1937 at the II European Basketball Championship in Riga (Latvia). Back then, Joniškis was the first city where the returning Lithuanian basketball team was greeted by the local government and fans with flowers and brass band marches.

26. COGNITIVE WALKWAY OF MŪŠOS TYRELIS

Cognitive Walkway of Mūšos Tyrelis was opened in 2015 and it is the longest known walkway in the swamps that was included in the Lithuanian Book of Records. The total length of the walkway is 5775,87 metres. The walkway is located in the exclusive natural area – Mūša Tyrelis Telmological Reserve. This natural complex in Northern Lithuania consists of several types of swamps, peatlands, and wetlands. Rivers the Mūša and the Juodupis, natural Miknaičiai lake and several other small lakes are floating in the swamp. The cognitive walkway of Mūša Tyrelis can also be visited independently, without the escorts of the staff of Žagarė Regional Park.

..... 27. RIDGE AND 2ND MOUND (ŽVELGAITIS HILL) OF ŽAGARĖ



Žagarė Ridge is a long, narrow formation of sand and gravel, formed by glaciers. While travelling this 3,6-kilometre long cognitive walkway you can admire the picturesque nature, observe the birds, animals or insects, and camp out. There are gazebos, observation towers, information stands, fireplaces, a basketball court, beach volleyball court, car parks, outdoor toilets, changing rooms, and many more. The second mound of Žagarė, called by local people Žvelgaitis Hill, is one of the stops in Žagarė Ridge cognitive walkway. According to local people, the legendary castle of Lithuanian duke Žvelgaitis was standing on the mound in the 13th century.

..... 28. ŽAGARĖ MANOR FARMSTEAD AND PARK



The Žagarė manor farmstead is one of the largest surviving manor farmsteads in Lithuania. In the late 18th century, Russian queen Catherine II gave Žagarė manor to her favourite Platon Zubov. In 1858, the manor was bought by the duke Dmitry Naryshkin. The Naryshkin family rebuilt and enlarged the manor, turning it into a lavish English-style residence. Several groups of buildings unfold in the plain relief: the residential house, surrounded by the park; the stud farm complex not far away from it; further away northward, farm buildings, the mill, and manor workers' houses. 29. JAKIŠKIAI MANOR

Jakiškiai manor is mentioned in historical sources as early as in the late 16th century. To this day, the 17-room manor with classicist features, built in 1898, has survived. The construction of the manor was initiated by the owner of the manor German Koškolis. The large manor farm buildings burned down during the war, only the icehouse building, the basement, and the building with a steam mill survived till our days. The manor is not restored and is still authentic. The private Jakiškiai manor fascinates artists: cultural and art events are arranged, movies are filmed here, and arriving guests are greeted by a permanent exhibition of paintings, giving the manor a bohemian touch. The manor hosts events in as many as 6 halls.

30. GASČIŪNAI CENTRE OF TRADITIONAL CRAFTS

Gasčiūnai is a village and an exclusive corner of Joniškis region, which is cherished and famous because of an active community. A documentary film has been created about the village. There is an ethnographic museum in a farm building made of clay where over 2000 different exhibits showing how our ancestors lived and worked are stored. The community also welcomes guests to visit the modern centre of traditional crafts. It offers educational programs: sticking and painting of clay, bread and buns are baked according to ancient recipes of our grandmothers. There are many ethnic celebrations in the Traditional Crafts Centre.

42. PAKRUOJIS OLD FIRE STATION

Pakruojis old fire station is located in the central part of the town. Pakruojis burned many times; therefore, in 1928, with the contribution of the Jewish community, a fire station penthouse was built. The wooden tower served for drying fire hoses, inventory was kept in other rooms of the building. Before World War II, a hand-operated siren was equipped. The hall was lit with carbide lamps; later, using electricity supplied by Pakruojis manor; and from 1934, with electricity produced by Maizelis' mill. Most of the firefighters were volunteers, and there was one paid firefighter-guard. After the renovation of Pakruojis old fire station in 2020, its premises house a cultural and artistic space.

46. ROZALIMAS FOREST PARK AND ZIGMANTIŠKIAI STONE WITH MARY'S FOOT

Rozalimas forest nature education and recreational park established near Rozalimas town with its recreational hiking trail is intended for acquaintance with Rozalimas pine forest, a vast range of stands, the land's mythological history, and other interesting objects. The educational trail is about 4,5 km long. It stretches through the forest, the massif of which extends north of Rozalimas along the road 149 Smilgiai-Pakruojis. The route is equipped with the necessary infrastructure: 18 information stands, rest areas, and arrows. Zigmantiškės stone is situated about 2 km northwest of Rozalimas. The legend tells of the apparition of St Virgin Mary who left this "foot" to shepherds.

47. STAČIŪNAI WINDMILL

The mill was built in 1890. In Soviet times, it was turned into a warehouse and did not serve its original purpose. In 2004, the mill was restored. It is one of a few surviving windmills whose ground floor is constructed using stone masonry and has decorative elements, while the others are wooden. It is the only windmill in Pakruojis district with an inner cap rotation mechanism. Currently, the exposition of the milling equipment, the photos of Stačiūnai community life, various folk household items are displayed, travelling expositions are organized, and educational programmes are offered.





..... 50. BURBIŠKIS MANOR

Burbiškis manor has been known since the 16th century. In 1819, the manor was acquired by the Baženskiai family who built a peculiar manor of Romanticism, Historicism and Neo-Gothic styles, reminding of a fortress. The new owners have also created an impressive, scenic 28-hectare park distinguishing itself by exceptional small architecture, ponds, tree-lined alleys, viewpoints, and islands. The park is adorned with the sculptures of Vytautas the Great and Adam Mickiewicz, for the first time created in Lithuania by Kazimieras Ulianskis.

The museum established in Burbiškis manor aims to restore as accurate picture of the past as possible, conveying the old culture of manors. The spaces of the manor farmstead house the exhibitions of the manor history, carriages, old technical equipment, houseplants, and tulips.

Every spring, the manor hosts the tulip flowering festivals well-known throughout Lithuania and abroad, poetry events “Poezijos pavasaris”, chamber concerts, and exhibitions.

52. KLEBONIŠKIAI RURAL HOUSEHOLD MUSEUM



Kleboniškiai Rural Household Museum has been established in the valley of the Daugynė River, in a former village site and occupies the area of 18 ha. Its exposition contains buildings characteristic of the 19th century and the beginning of the 20th century, relocated from vicinities. These are cottages, granaries, baths, threshing floors, and barns. The surviving homesteads are neighbored by the restored ones. To revive the old countryside, 11 buildings have been moved from other locations. There is a total of 28 buildings in the village, 18 of which belong to the museum. The village has a windmill built in 1884. The old trees of the former village site and the thatched roofs of the buildings add authenticity to the museum; while its inhabitants, reality. The village hosts exhibitions, educational programs, evening parties, attracts by its threshing floor theatre performances, folk music and crafts, and Shrovetide celebrations.

In the spring of 1961, the Soviet Government decided “to deal with” the Hill of Crosses. Despite everything, the Hill of Crosses remained a symbol of heroic resistance and belief in freedom throughout the whole period of Lithuanian occupation.

The Hill of Crosses became famous all over the world after the visit of Pope John Paul II here on September 7, 1993.

In the autumn of 1993, during his visit to Franciscan Monastery of Mount La Verne in Italy and a few weeks after his trip around Lithuania, the Pope John Paul II said that there were two special hills in Europe – Mount La Verne and the Hill of Crosses and that these two hills had to be bridged. He urged Franciscan brothers to build a monastery near the Hill of Crosses. The Franciscans promptly responded to the Pope's encouragement. The construction of the building, standing 300 meters away from the Hill of Crosses, was started by Franciscan brothers of Tuscany province. The monastery was solemnly consecrated on July 8, 2000.

58. KURTUVĖNAI

A nobleman's farmstead existed in Kurtuvėnai as early as in the 14th century. The first owner of Kurtuvėnai manor Mykolas Jaugelavičius is mentioned in 1495. It is also known that other famous owners of the manor were the families of Kešgailai, Nagurskiai, Oginskiai, Tiškevičiai, and Zyberk Pliateriai.

Today, Kurtuvėnai manor entertainment complex offers an incredible abundance of services: riding camps for children, a riding school, a photo session with horses, children's birthdays in the stud farm, a two horseshoe hike, a 6-day horse ride Kurtuvėnai-Palanga, carriage rides, carriage rental, hippotherapy (therapeutic riding) for children and adults, a ride with a carriage drawn by two horses, a horse hotel, various excursions, educational programs, bicycle routes, and a wide range of numerous manor attractions in Kurtuvėnai manor. Visitors can also enjoy great local food and traditional events, admire a surviving park, horse stud, ponds, a restored wooden Baroque-style barn and a wheel building workshop. In 2019, a new visitor centre was established.

59. NAISIAI

Naisiai is known for its Museum of Baltic Gods, the only museum of this kind in Lithuania, adorned with more than 50 oak sculptures of Baltic Gods. Other unique museums in Naisiai are the Museum of Bird Nesting Boxes, the Museum of Baltic Herbage, and Šiauliai Regional Literature Museum that has operated for as many as 37 years.

The landscape is enriched with paganism expressed by attractions such as Saulė Square (Sun Square), Alka Hill (Sacred Hill), Ugnis Square (Fire Square), Mėnulio akis (the Moon's Eye), Lake Laimė (Lake Happiness), Meilė Island (Island of Love), and the impressively large Baltai Arena (Arena of the Balts). Naisiai is also known for its professional theatre "Naisių vasara" ("Naisiai Summer"), Ramūnas Karbauskis' Žemaitukai horse stud, a paintball centre, swing park, and other attractions.

.....60. A MINI ZOOLOGICAL GARDEN - THE ALPACAS' FARM IN DARGAIČIAI.....



The alpacas' farm and the mini zoological garden are located in the village of Dargaičiai, in Šiauliai district. It is one of the largest gardens in northern Lithuania and the Baltic States, which accepts individual visitors and excursion groups. Farmers tell stories where alpacas came from and how they appeared in Lithuania, what the animals are special about, present alpacas' wool, and its products that can also be bought here.

The most enjoyable part of the visit is getting to know alpacas and other animals. Currently, the farm is a home to 21 different animal species: alpacas, llamas, a camel, chinchillas, REX rabbits, donkeys, Queensland sheep, Dutch pygmy goats, the Falabella miniature horse (the smallest breed in the world), African ostriches, Jacob sheep, Coburg fox sheep, Highland cow, Arabian horse, and black nose sheep.

.....61. THE CENTRE OF ETHNIC CULTURE AND TRADITIONAL CRAFTS OF ŠIAULIAI DISTRICT MUNICIPALITY

The first wooden chapel was built in the depths of Agailiai forest as early as in the times of serfdom. Believing in the magic of this place, people were building crosses here for a long time. In 1939, a small concrete church with a wooden tiled roof was built. During World War II, it was set on fire. Later it was rebuilt, but in 1974, it burnt down the second time after being struck by lightning. In 1910, the church was restored. It is included in the list of cultural values of Kuršėnai rural eldership.

In 2004-2005, the church was renovated with the funds of Kuršėnai forest enterprise. In 2006, a walking trail leading to the spring whose water is considered magical and has healing powers was equipped.

..... 63. KURTUVĖNAI CHURCH OF ST JACOB THE APOSTLE

The towers of Kurtuvėnai church of St Jacob the Apostle have been supporting the sky since 1792, upon the completion of the construction of the sanctuary, which lasted a decade. The snowy white 50-meter-tall towers of the church built in the late-Baroque style can be seen from far away. The church is adorned by the family coat of arms of the founder of the church count Jokūbas Nagurskis, located above the main entrance to the building. The interior of the church breathes reticent classicism, but aesthetic elements of late Baroque and neo-Gothic can be also discovered here. The ensemble of five altars and a pulpit was completed in 1820. This event is commemorated by a memorial plaque affixed to the church pillar.

Twelve crypts are walled in the basements of Kurtuvėnai Church of St Jacob the Apostle. It is believed that the nobles who ruled Kurtuvėnai manor and other representatives of the nobility were buried in this basement.

..... 64. KURŠĖNAI MANOR HOMESTEAD AND PARK

The history of Kuršėnai manor begins in 1564, when Žygimantas Augustas gave this manor in leno right to Jurgis Despot Zinovičius, Polock castle supervisor. In 1621, the manor went to S. Pacas, the treasurer of the Grand Duchy of Lithuania; and a decade later, to Jurgis Gruževskis and his wife. At the end of the 18th century, Kuršėnai was inherited by Steponas Gruževskis. In 1811, having invited the artist J. Rilkė with the entire apprentice brigade, he built a new (current) manor house, a chapel and repaired other buildings. The manor flourished even more under the reign of his younger son Edward, to whom the manor was passed in 1846.

During World War I, the Germans who settled in the manor destroyed the park, the manor and took away most valuable items. Thanks to advanced farming in the interwar period the manor flourished. In 1940, the manor was nationalized.

Kuršėnai manor is the only most valuable legacy of wooden manor architecture in Šiauliai district.

The history of the establishment of the museum is related to Enrikas Juzeliūnas, the then director of the forest enterprise, who had the horns of the auroch – the ancient Lithuanian forest animal, found on the slopes of the Dubysa river. These were about 2000-year-old horns – an extremely rare and interesting exhibit that was also evaluated by Prof. Tadas Ivanauskas. Together with the Directorate of Tytuvėnai Regional Park, the forest enterprise takes care of the management of the museum's display and supplements it with new exhibits. Today, the museum invites to admire an interesting collection of garden and forest birds, get acquainted with forest animals and their way of life, evaluate the great diversity of insects in this area, and admire the woodwork of local folk craftsmen.



KRIAUČIUS STONE

Kriaučius stone (Tailor's Stone) lies in a flat ploughed field, near the road Kražiai-Jauniškė, almost on the top of a streamlined 157-meter-high hillock. This boulder is the third largest in Lithuania. The length of the boulder is 7,84 metres; its width, 7,65 metres; and height, over 4 metres; the maximum horizontal circumference is 23,2 metres. This boulder (more precisely, its small upper part protruding above the ground) has long been known to the locals. However, only in 1974, the reclamators working here pushed the ground with a bulldozer for the first time and exposed the rear of the boulder more widely. In 1989, using pulley blocks with arm-thick ropes and two anchors dug in the ground, borrowed from the Mažeikiai Oil Refinery, the boulder was pulled out to the surface and dragged to the nearest hillock in Vileikiai village.



Legends tell that once hags lived here and witches spread with devils, arranged devils' weddings. According to other legends, the mound was poured with handfuls of Swedish troops.

Girnikai mythological hill is one of the most valuable and most visited exceptional values of Kurtuvėnai Regional Park with the most popular observation platform in the regional park. It is the highest hill in the territory of Šiauliai district (183,4 m), overlooking the panorama of Kurtuvėnai regional park, Samogitian highlands, the city of Šiauliai, and the towns of Kuršėnai and Kurtuvėnai. Stories tell that Girnikai sacred hill is the tomb of the giants' mother Kurtuovė; church lost in the hill and the stone on the top of the hill, on which the holy fire used to burn, are mentioned. The mountain united three Baltic tribes: Samogitians, Curonians, and Semigallians.

The Dubysa is one of the most beautiful rivers in Lithuania and the most popular water tourism routes. The picturesque steep-slope old valley of the Dubysa, the mounds resting on the banks, natural alpine meadows, gurgling of the tributaries streaming on the slopes, the campsites suitable for an overnight stay, and the rural tourism homesteads create an atmosphere suitable for recreation. There are campsites with gazebos, fireplaces, and etc. at the beginning and at the end of the route.
